Course Description and Summary

The MT literacy training institute is a transformative two-week program designed to empower missionaries, Bible translators, church leaders, and language enthusiasts with the knowledge and skills to promote basic literacy in diverse linguistic communities. This institute recognizes the pivotal role that mother tongues play in fostering Bible reading in churches and communities with significant rates of illiteracy.

Today there are more than 700 million adult illiterates around the world. As advances in Bible translation continue to be made, there is need for missionary agencies and churches to prepare tutors and trainers who will support Bible reading in local languages.
