

2023 Annual Report

Introduction:

Literacy Ministry Ukraine (LMU) became an LEI Member Nation partner in 2021. It provides local literacy teacher training workshops, Bible-based reading primers and coaching of new literacy teachers. In addition, LMU also provides teaching English as a foreign language (EFL). LMU's board consists of 7 board members.

Viktoriia Rohozhnikova graduated from the International Literacy Training Institute in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in August 2018 and has served as a missionary in Ukraine since 2019.

In autumn of 2018 a group of Ukrainians, Polish, Trans Carpathian Romas and Americans (Viktoriia Rohozhnikova, Viktoriia Suponina, Milena Svencicka, Svitlana Tyrpak, Angelina Diord', Iryna Surmai, Ruslan Surmai, Georg Ort, Martha Ort, Virginia Newton) gathered to work on a Ukrainian primer and in April of 2019 it was printed.



In April of 2020 a team, that included Elena Kozinets, Viktoriia Rohozhnikova, Milena Svencicka, Anatoliy Shkarin, Virginia Newton, Georg Ort and Martha Ort, revised the Russian primer for literacy students "Zaria Pravdy" (Заря правды) and LMU published new version of the primer with a new title "Doroga k svetu" (Дорога к свету).

Since 2018 there were 5 TTWs (Tutor Training Workshops).

Support during the time of war

In February 2022 Russia attacked Ukraine and occupied some of its territories. Many people moved to other locations and besides Literacy Ministry and EFL Ministry, LMU also have supported many individuals and families providing food packages and bottled water, vegetables and flour, medicine and reading glasses, hygiene items and laundry powder, clothes, shoes and funds to support people in need as well, sharing the Good News with them. Over 2,250.00 dollars were received and distributed to help those in need.



EFL Ministry: In spite of the war for most part of 2023, English as a Foreign Language continued both online and as in-person classes. Especially among the younger generation there is a great need and interest for learning English. A lot of children now do distance learning as it is impossible to have classes at school



buildings in many areas of Ukraine due to air attacks and ruined school buildings. As a result, many of the children require to have additional help with a school program.



Also EFL became a part of Youth Ministry in the Living Well Church and up to 40 teenagers are reached through English classes,

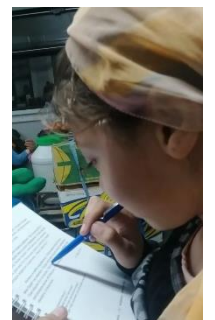
because the inclusive approach is based on God's word.



Literacy Ministry:



Previous year there wasn't a possibility to have TTW, but in 2023 LMU held one TTW in Ivano-Frankivsk, West Ukraine, for a group of potential tutors, who have their ministries among Roma people, and two of them were Roma themselves. As a result, there were 4 literacy students in Odessa, South Ukraine, both children and adults.

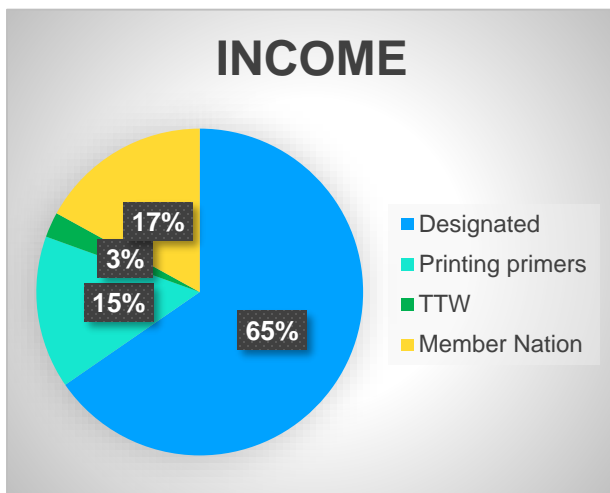

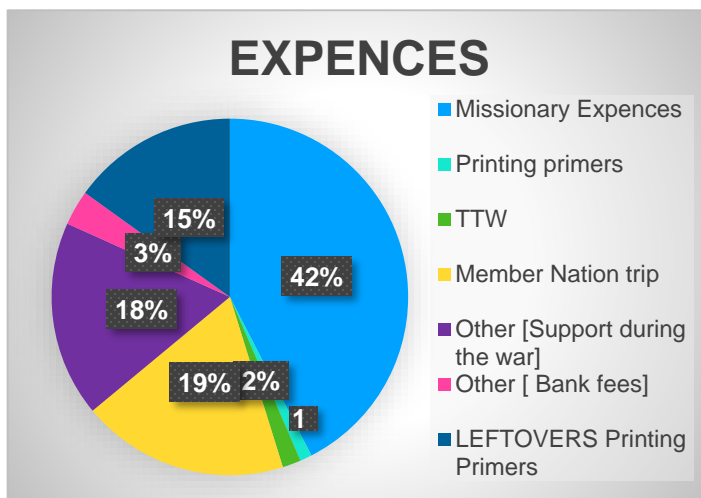
