When the world experienced great unexpected difficulties, there were no activities during the Pandemic. But as the Pandemic en ded by the grace of God, the work of the literacy is slowly gaining vitality. Because of the extremely low illiteracy rate in Korea, we focused on Teacher Training Workshop in the field of mission aries in Korea and overseas missionaries rather than illiterate e ducation. We look forward to God's amazing things to do in the future.

A total of 17 people, including Korean Christian leaders, a Pakistani missionary, attended the TTW on May 29, 2023 at the Osam Power Church in Anyang. Many Koreans were involved in multicultural ministry.

Although the pandemic has not been fully resolved, the TTW was held on July 15, 2022 at Osam Power Church. Missionaries Jeon, Dae-woong and Park, Hye-sook, who work in Bangladesh, attend ed TTW before the pandemic, but did not use it. At the end of the pandemic, they started Literacy ministry in Bangladesh. When they saw the explosion of the gospel, they actively promoted TTW when they came to Korea. A total of 14 people, including Korean missionaries who are staying in their home countries, church leaders, a Chinese missionary and a Vietnamese missionary, attended the TTW, and everyone felt that education for the illiterate was a powerful tool for missionary work, vo wing to be loyal to spread the gospel.



Missionaries Jeon, Dae-woong and Park, Hye-sook, who work in Bangladesh, actively pushed for an other TTW while they were in Korea. A total of 15 people, including Korean missionaries staying in the eir hometowns and Korean church leaders, attended the TTW. The missionary who preached in the remote areas of the Himalayas also showed interest in Primer Construction.

On August 26 and September 23, 2023, a TTW was held in Bangladesh at YWAM School and Ro semawi, attended by couples from Silet, the easternmost part of Bangladesh, from Kosabaja, and from Shimol. Missionary Park Hye-sook and Rose Moye also showed practical demonstrations. Th rough Literay education, churches are formed in many places, and some Hindu believers gather to meet the gospel and receive Jesus as their Savior, which is a great hope for the poor and widows.

Mangochi prison literacy class



God reopened the literacy education in March this year, which was closed in March 2020 due to the pandemic and closed for two years. Allowed the guard in charge to train three police officers and six inmate teachers to restart the literacy class. A total of thirty -two learners were taught, and for the first time female inmates joined the literacy class, and within two weeks half of the learners were able to read and write. There are a total of 102 students.

In June 2023, we trained 54 teachers at a church-planting school in Nampula, Mozambique, who began reading and writing classes in several villages in northern Mozambique, where they come from.

There is a growing need for literacy classes in very remote areas, which necessitates increased funding to train volunteer teachers in three villages, and to purchase primers and stationery.

I want to create a literacy center with two classrooms and one community library to train literacy teachers and use them to run literacy classes.

From July 10 to 13, 2023, Pastor Maxw ell and Chancey trained students at a church planting school in Nampula, Mozambique, led by Pastor Ademola and his wife Bilha. In another, the TTW was conducted with pastor Welsh Sawa ri and a total of 24 students, who had to drive 1,060km round trip from Mangochi to Nampula.

Phoebe Park participated in the '2023 Member Nation Gathering' held in Belo Horizonte, Brazil from October 20 to 26, 2023 as the president of LEI (Literacy Evangelism International) Korea.

More than 40 leaders from 15 member countries of LEI (Ghana, Malawi, Nigeria, N. Macedonia, USA, Benin, Burkina Faso, Brazil, Ukraine, India, Canada, Kenya, Republic of Congo, Togo, Korea) shared the ministry of each country so that it can expand the ministry, and encouraged each other.







Phoebe Park gave a presentation on the current ministry and future direction of the Global Literacy Mission (GLM)

Dr. Rice, the president of the LEI USA, prayed for her.

She also reported on the activities of those who have attended Teacher Training Workshop and the ministries of missionaries (Bangladesh, Mongolia and Nepal) who are active abroad.



Phoebe Park also explained about the Korean alphabet picture book which is illustrated and written by her. She wanted to use the proceeds for the literacy ministry.

He founded GLM in 1999 and has made primers for 16 countries (Korea, Mongolia, Nepal, Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, Cambodia, Indonesia, China, Russia, Lahu, Myanmar, Philippines, Kazakhstan, Sri Lanka, Hmong) in Southeast Asia as the president of LEI Southeast Asia for the past 25 years and devoted himself to the literacy ministry...

Pastor Park Bok-ae(Phoebe), who serves as the GLM Education Director, took over as the president of LEI Korea and Southeast Asia after Dr. Kim Nam-hyun.
