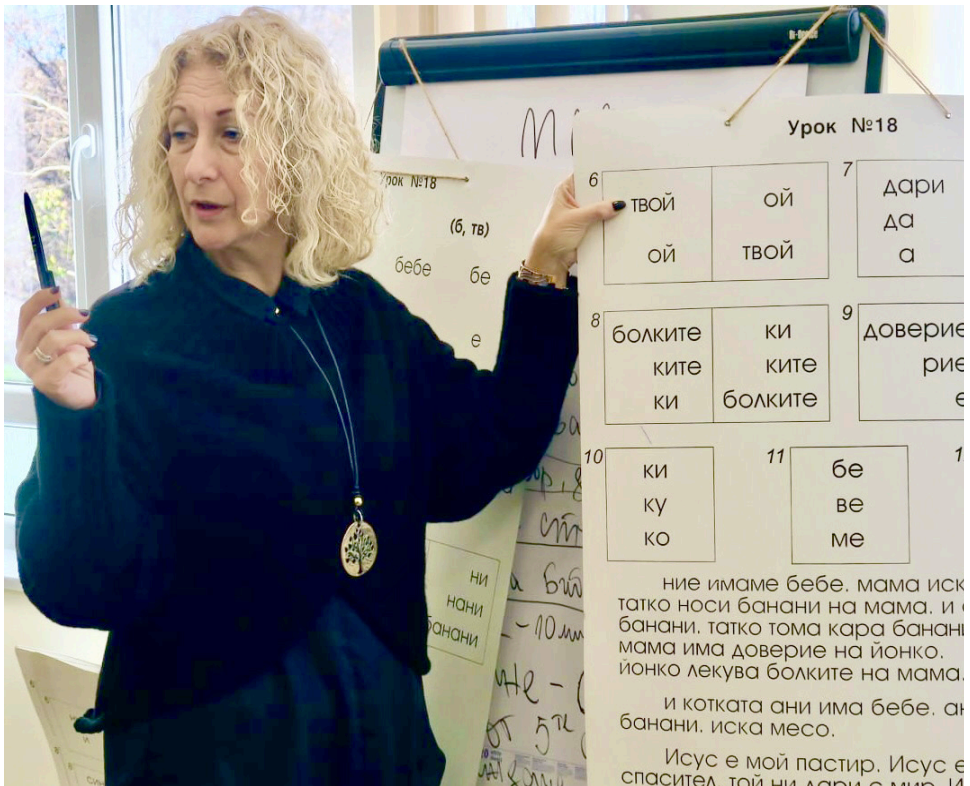

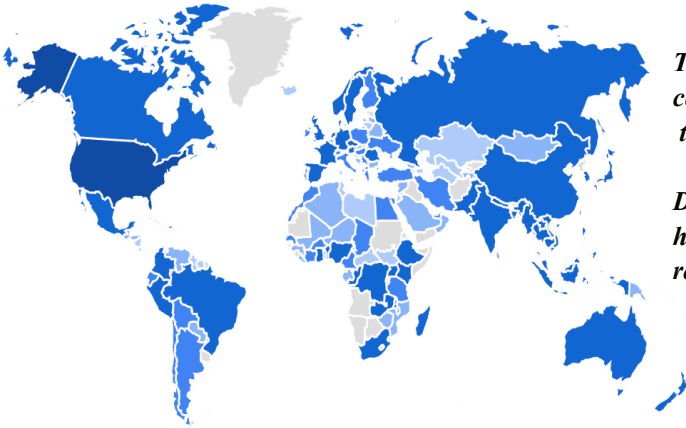

New Member Nation Partners - 2024

L&E Congo- Brazzaville



Located on the western coast of Central Africa, Congo-Brazzaville joins other Africa, French-speaking countries as a new Member Nation. Director Rev. Pierre Manguinga pioneers the ministry, sharing the message of Jesus through literacy.

With more than 25 years of literacy ministry experience, Rev. Manguinga has witnessed the transforming joy in hundreds of new readers when they are able to read the Bible and accept Jesus as LORD and Savior.

L&E Guatemala



Since 2014, Rev. Yovany Hernandez and his wife Esmeralda have been pointing people to Jesus through the blessing of reading. Organizing the L&E Guatemala Member Nation was the logical next step. As a pastor, Rev. Hernandez witnessed that people could not read their Bibles, so he and Esmeralda are using LEI's Spanish primers to train literacy tutors to teach others to read, making "disciples of all nations," while sharing the gift of literacy.

Planting Seeds

The seeds of literacy ministry in Europe are sprouting! From the USA to Ukraine, Georg and Martha Ort's efforts continue to foster people and primers, especially for the Roma people.

The Ort's long-time encouragement in Ukraine has nurtured and supported Vika (L&E Ukraine) whose multifaceted compassion serves her country with literacy training and classes.

Vika has led workshops in the Odesa region where Roma people have settled.

A local Roma pastor desires salvation for his people. He and his youngest son took the training to lead and inspire others who are interested in helping the Roma know Jesus through learning to read and write.

A few of these trained literacy tutors have provided classes for Roma children living in the area. The Orts planted, Vika waters, and God is causing the growth.



The 5-Step Bridge

Jesus' command to love your neighbor is not hindered by language or abilities.

Recently an English-speaking tutor in California reached out to help her Spanish-speaking neighbor.

Trusting Jesus' sufficiency and the five instructional steps designed by Dr. Robert Rice, tutor and new reader, Rosario, work through the Spanish primer, *Nuevos Caminos*. Despite the tutor's beginning Spanish skills and Rosario's lifetime of illiteracy, Rosario is determined to read God's Word.

By the fifth lesson, Rosario exclaimed, "Estoy leyendo!" (I am reading.) She is not simply repeating the tutor's words. She is reading the sound combinations to form words which bring understanding to sentences and stories! The learning relationship of the two who come with trusting hearts is doubly blessed, for both are learning Spanish albeit one for reading and writing and the other for listening and speaking.

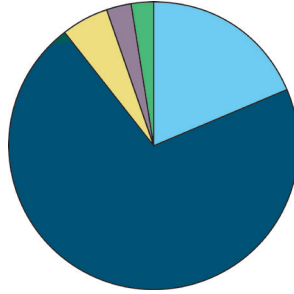

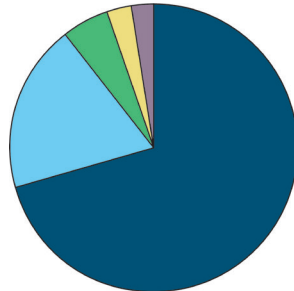

Ana Biederman Literacy Trailblazer | 30 Years

Ana Biederman's influence and inspiration extend across continents and beyond classrooms. Since playing the vital role of launching AEI Brazil in 1994, Ana celebrates 30 years of LEI ministry, and continues to serve as LEI's Coordinator for Brazil.

Ana came to LEI in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in 1994 for training in literacy ministry, with the help of an interpreter. She then returned to her home country to plant the seeds that would allow AEI Brazil to take root.

After meeting Rev. Bob Biederman at the training (LEI's Managing Director for N. America

and Europe), they were married in Brazil and lived there for nine months while nurturing AEI Brazil.

Returning to the US, Ana and Bob continued to participate in primer construction and tutor training events overseas.

As a leukemia survivor, Ana enthusiastically witnesses to her faith in Jesus and of her passion for literacy.

Now fluent in English, Ana pursues a PhD in Educational Administration and Leadership. She continues to testify to the Good News of Jesus and share the LEI vision so all may receive the gift of reading God's Word.

AEI BRAZIL 30 YEARS OF LITERACY IMPACT

On November 25, AEI (LEI) Brazil celebrated 30 years of continuous ministry in that populous South American country.

In November 1994, Ana Biederman returned from Literacy & Evangelism training in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to become an LEI missionary to her home country.

She left her job as a teacher and assistant principal with a conviction from God to help people learn to read the Bible and share the Good News of salvation through Jesus.

It was not easy at first as she supported herself teaching Portuguese and English to seminary students. Some of them volunteered to do office work and then a small church gave money for a secretary.

As the work grew, First Presbyterian Church in Belo Horizonte embraced the vision. Seminarians studying at the seminary there became pastors who realized the people's need for literacy and invited Ana to conduct trainings in

their churches.

For over 50 years, LEI has taught people to read using Bible-content primers so Christians can become daily readers of God's Word, and non-Christians can hear the Gospel. For the past 30 years, AEI Brazil's program has become a model of LEI work for other countries to emulate, becoming a forerunner of the current 17 Member Nation partners.

Elder Anderson Fleming gave a tribute to Ana Biederman and LEI's work in the morning worship service in November, and other key workers were recognized.

First Presbyterian Church continues to provide an office and support for this work. Ana and Bob were privileged to attend the anniversary through YouTube, thankful they could participate in the special celebration. What a joy to celebrate three decades of LEI ministry in Brazil.

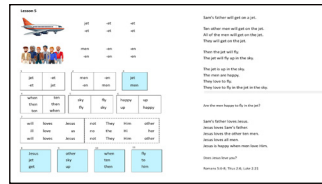
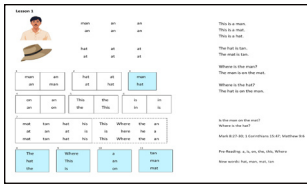


Refreshing Update for Firm Foundations

Recently, a team of Literacy & Evangelism (LEI) directors and missionaries has met online to review, revise, and refresh the FF's three reading books (primers), their workbooks, and the Pre-reader. This revision team is

assessing and updating the English literacy lessons for cultural variety as well as lesson relevance and unity for today's literacy-evangelism impact. With updates such as the addition of culturally diverse, color pictures and ten new Bible-story lessons, the team upholds the signature, tried-and-true, easy-to-use Literacy & Evangelism method and lesson format so that the teaching is simple, and the students' success is prioritized. We look forward with eager anticipation to the completion of this Firm Foundations curriculum revision.

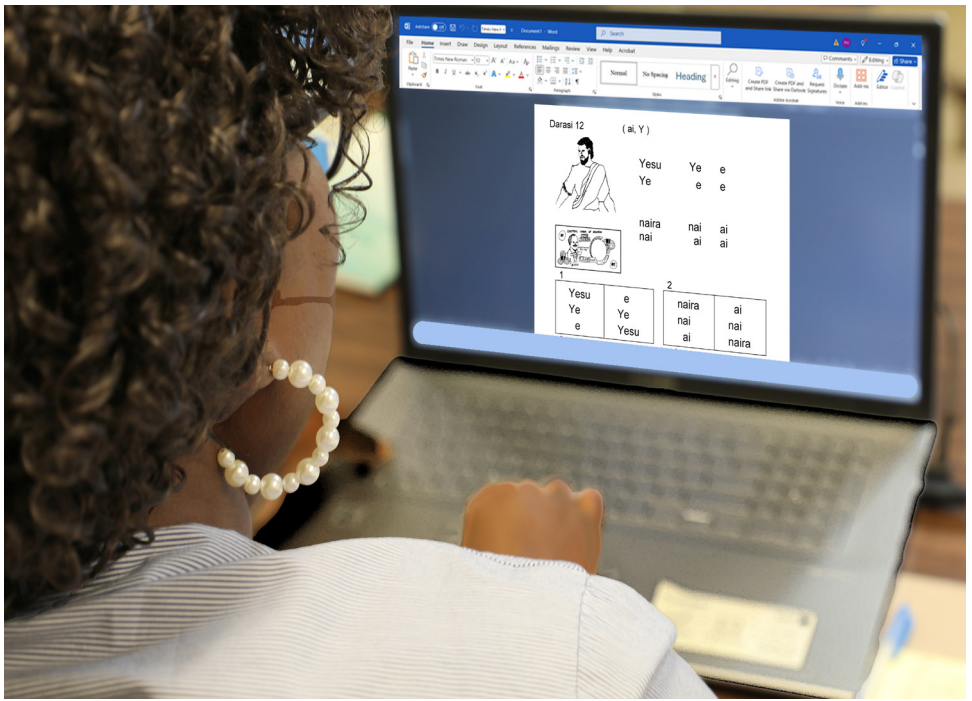

Celine is 80 years old and was one of 23 participants in LEI Director of Francophone Africa, David Nabine's Tutor Training Workshop in Madagascar. At the end of the training and after receiving her certificate of participation, she was asked: Why, at your age, did you decide to take part in this Literacy Tutor Training Workshop? She confidently replied, "It's true that I'm 80 years old, and I can read my Bible. But given the illiteracy rate in my country, I'm very moved, which is why I want to make my contribution. With my age, I won't be able to train others, but I can still raise awareness and encourage men and women to enroll in literacy classes to learn to read and write. They'll be able to read the Bible, write their names and so on. I think that in this way, I too will have contributed to the development of my country."

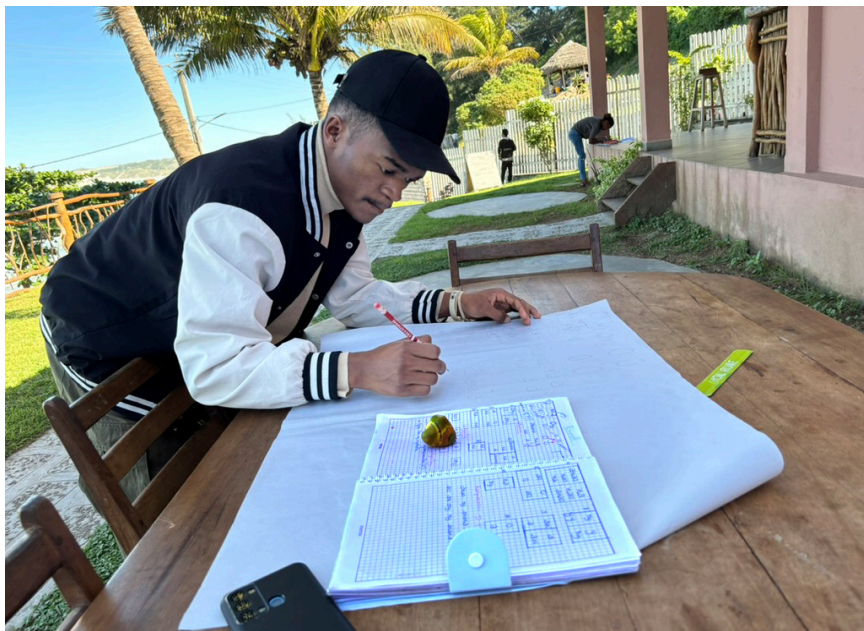
