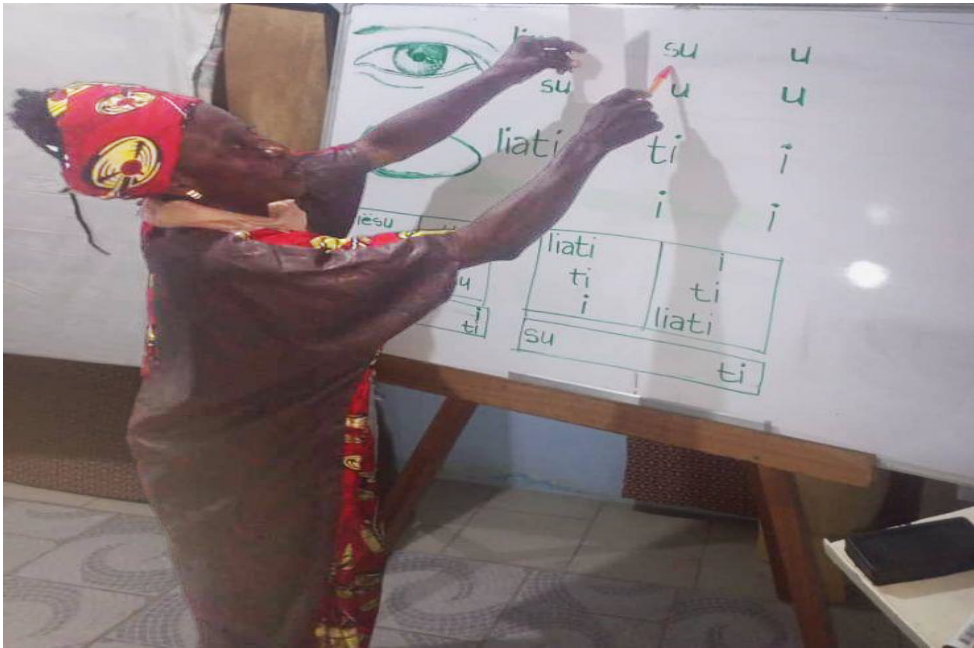

■ ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT

In accordance with our 2025 action plan, we have focused our efforts on finding local partners to carry out the planned activities, namely:

A. Syllabary creation workshop

We have concluded an agreement with the mission of the Christian Alliance (C.M.A.) to finance (in part) and support two workshops for creating syllabaries in local languages (VILI and KITUBA).

These two workshops will be held during the year 2026 and note that we have already started the pre-workshop phase since November 2025.

We continue to contact other partners for future projects, including the opening of classes among indigenous people (pygmies).

B. Instructor training workshop



With the contribution of local partners, we managed to organize three instructor training workshops during the year 2025.

C. Opening of classes

We have opened at least (nine) 9 classes across 3 departments of our country, and we have added two (2) additional classes for students of 2024 who were unable to complete their lessons. It should also be noted that we have set up a class in the prison which works remarkably well (see statistics table)

D. Missionary trips

Despite the difficult economic situation, we made a total of six mission trips (training, monitoring, evaluation, etc.).

E. Prayer and Intercession

With the help of the Holy Spirit, we continue to intercede for all those involved in our ministry (trainers, learners, volunteer staff, etc.). We also support prayer sessions that take place regionally (African) and internationally.

F. Requests

Let us pray to God for the holding and smooth running of our two (2) workshops which will be held during the current year (2026). We are requesting financial support from LEI (see project)

Testimony of Thérèse, a committed Christian woman

My name is MOULOMBO Thérèse (78 years old). I am a determined Christian woman. After my husband died, I left the city to return to my native village.

I undertook to set up a prayer cell based on the principles of evangelical doctrine. However, illiteracy was a major obstacle for the church.

When I learned that a training course for literacy instructors was being organized in the neighboring town, I took the opportunity to register. After that, I created a literacy class which welcomed 13 students.

Today, I am proud to see that my efforts have borne fruit. I now have colleagues who have changed their mentality and who are able to master the biblical exhortation and certain tasks. This way I can delegate certain responsibilities.

I thank the literacy program which has made it possible to qualitatively transform the lives of many people.
