### LEI Canada Ministry:

- Ottawa ESL Prayer Network meeting monthly. / SOCEM prayer monthly meeting
- Lorna:
  - She continues teaching online. Continues her training with online classes. Her on-line Eritrean ladies class some have finished A1 level of Light of the World (LOTW).
  - She attended the every 3 year Mennonite Gathering in Kitchner representing LEI and Light of the World.

### LAMP – Guatemala / Byron Feliz Temaj

LAMP will continue with ministry as funds allow. They are still receiving funding from donations to LEI-USA, funds from LEI Canada and local donations.

The completion of the Mam Old Testament Translation. Jan 25, the dedication of the complete Mam Bible. LAMP continues to promote literacy in Mam, studying the Bible. Now more unity in the church, an answer to prayer.

- Pray for God's provision, especially in matters of health. Pray for continued ministry above.

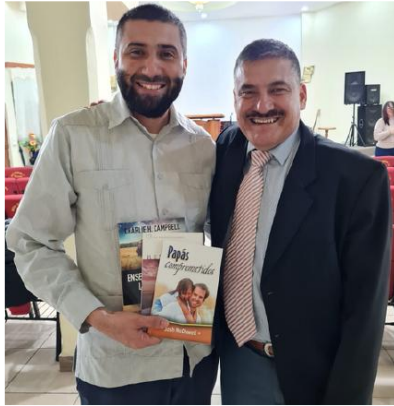


### **L&E Guatemala New Paths: Yovany & Esmeralda Hernandez**

They continue English classes with Lorna (via Zoom) twice a week using the Light of the World ESL curriculum.

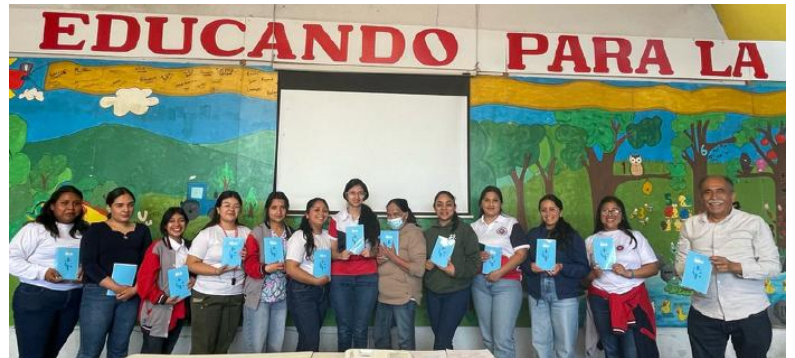




In answer to much prayer and door knocking... they saw the fruit of perseverance as they conducted a teacher training workshop in Chimaltenango for the ministry of "Educating for Life", where we try to reach the mothers of the students. This community is indigenous. One of the goals of this ministry is to help mothers in a comprehensive manner, since most of them do not have educational opportunities.

The Bible Seminary received training for 40 students who want to use literacy ministry as their practical fieldwork.

Also ministry with social assistance to garbage collectors; shoe distribution, promoting literacy and Bible reading; counseling with young people, and distribution of Bibles.

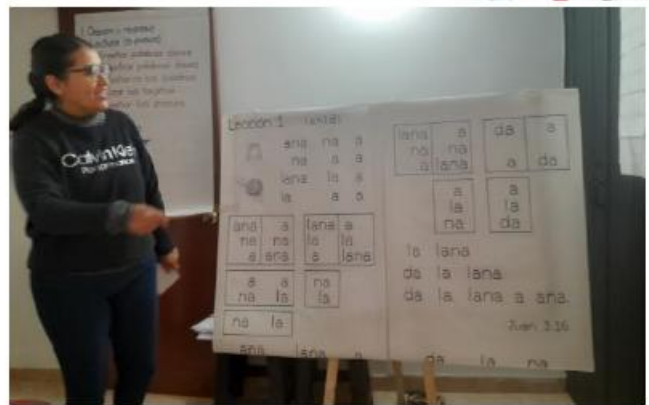
From June Report:

Had a successful Primer Practicum Workshop Sep 25 – Oct 16<sup>th</sup>. Hosted 12 trainees to develop the Effutu language – Nigeria -7, Ghana-2, Togo-1, Benin-1, USA-1

Continue to finalize Effutu language primer and are making preparations for 2 additional primers in 2026, plus teacher trainings.
