A Regional Literacy Training Institute was held at Kolkata from 16th November to 29th November. A total of 47 people were trained in AL, ESL and Leadership. Many of them took part in all the modules and have started literacy classes in their churches, schools and communities..

I am Jaba Murmu from a village in Jharkhand. I never had the opportunity to study at a school. The school was far from the village and my parents did not pay attention to my studies. You could say that I was, in a way, completely illiterate. I would never take a Bible or hymn book to church, because, even though I really wanted to read the Bible, I could not. By the grace of God, one day the light of education came into my life. LII, in partnership with Maj kristin started literacy classes here in our center. I began studying at that center and learned to read Roman script within two years. Now I can read the Bible and understand God's word. I am very grateful for the literacy program and this opportunity to learn.

I am Debilal from a village in Jharkhand. My parents died when I was five years old, so I grew up in my uncle's house. I used to take care of the cows and goats there. No one encouraged me to go to school at that time, so I didn't get any education from school. I bought a primer book from the market when I was eight years old and learned to read from my friends. In 2024, a Literacy Teacher Training Workshop was organized by LII and I participated in that training. I learned a lot from that training. I have been teaching other people at the Literacy Center since 2024. I also taught Santhali Roman script reading to 6 learners through the Literacy Center, which has been completed, and currently 17 learners are studying at my center. This is how I serve the living God.
