A. Formal Registration with Corporate Affairs Commission.

The long awaited registration process of the Literacy and Evangelism Nigerian arm met stiff resistance from government authorities. Today, we give God the glory because the process was finally successful after persistent approaches to the Government. The certificate was duly present to us in October 2025 alongside the status report bearing Literacy and Evangelism Ministry. This will afford us opportunities to partner with government and other sister agencies towards enhancing our literacy and evangelism service in the country.

B. Bank Account: Over a long time, we have struggled to open our operational account with commercial bank in the country but the hindrance was lack of registration and recognition. This effort was further pushed and it was to be formalized in April 2026 by our former Country Director within such period he took ill and subsequent died. This will be actualize in July 2026.

- D. **Meetings:** LEM meets every 1st Monday of the month. We meet to pray, discuss and review our action plans to enable us fortify areas that needs to be fortified.
- E. **Awareness, Operational and Ongoing Classes.** There are ongoing classes across the country and recent ones opened in some parts of Plateau and Gombe states. In Evangelical Church Winning All (ECWA) Theological College in Billiri of Gombe State here in Nigeria there are ongoing classes both at the Seminary and the Secondary school sections of the College, our classes and Firm Foundations and the Hausa primer (Haske ga Mai Koyon Karatu) is been use to for beginners to introduce teaching students who cannot read. Last year 2025 November about 15 students were promoted from the Literacy class to Bible college class. Ten students form the basic class in the college section and five from the Secondary school section (ECWA JIM Collins memorial high School). TTW was organized by late Country Director Evang. Musa N. Waziri and his team. The woman who spoke here on behalf of the BETC Staff is one of the 19 persons trained since 2019. The School graduated the 2025 class in December. New classes are on. Pastor Micah L. Kalaye who received his TTW during the BETC also runs a literacy class in his Local Church at ECWA Sabon Layi in Tangale district. Rev Phaniel Silas is now overseeing the Gombe state axis LEM-N. Mary Daset is also doing wonderfully by organizing classes running in Rayfield Jos for Adults and Youth, most of whom are women and youths. Among these category, many have graduated, while other have gained admissions into tertiary institutions and other conventional schools. One major challenge is that, some of the graduates were school dropout while other are new converts from Islam including cleric (Sheik) and are facing financial problem which have also prevented them from seeking for education.

Currently there is a batch that are going to be graduated in September 2026.





- F. **The plague of the demise of Former Country Director.** The demise of our former Country Director Evang. Musa N. Waziri was sudden and shocking. The wave of the shock left the Nigerian Team uncertain of where to start in view of his great contribution to the growth of literacy ministry in Nigeria. Surprisingly, that same weekend that he took ill, he went for aware in a nearby community in Jos. We appreciate the LEI President Sid Rice and your team for identifying with us during that moment of bereavement.
