
Supporting Primer Construction

While our Canadian missionary, Carey Jo Johnston, did not travel to help develop primers, she has supported groups in our Member Nation partners in their primer efforts through video calls and editing primers. She continued to work with the A primer in

Ethiopia. These books are almost ready for printing. She assisted with several primers in Ghana (see below). Also, she helped with the Y primer in Brazil. As COVID prevented the Y missionary, Mary*, from traveling back to the village, the AEI Brazil team was able to complete the 32 lessons introducing the letters in the language, 11 health and culture stories, and the first 8 easy to read Bible stories. After returning to the village, Mary will continue to work on the Bible story lessons as well as test the first book.

Carolina has been leading teacher training workshops for literacy in Spanish and local languages in Colombia. She has assisted groups in developing literacy materials in their local languages. Carolina also attended the Partnership Development

course in Colombia.

She is working with Yukpa language materials in Venezuela. Also overcoming COVID.

In Colombia she has been developing the Koreguaje language primers.





Africa

Malawi -

Supporting literacy in Malawi as Maxwell

Mpitanyanga trains teachers in Lambya, Chewa, Yao and Sena languages.

Chewa language primers were printed. Now, Maxwell continuing with teacher training workshops.

Flooding happened again this year causing great difficulties for many of the teachers and literacy students.

Maxwell able to deliver 26 chalk boards, plus chalk, masks and dusters to classes.





Maxwell visited classes to give out certificates and held teacher training workshops.

Mrs. Veronica Gulupiya learned to read and is now teaching.

Supporting Literacy & Evangelism Ghana – the Ghana staff completed the Ga, Akuapem. Konkomba, Hausa, primers started. Rev. Carey Jo Johnston assisted in reviewing and editing materials via email and Zoom.

They carried out Teacher Trainer trainings with the Pentecostal church in many areas of Ghana. They

trained several hundered trainers over 4 different trainings.

They also celebrated World Literacy Day on September 8th.

Togo -


Supporting Literacy & Evangelism Togo – Director David Nabine and his wife Rose.

Gyan was also a co-facilitator for the on-line Primer Construction courses.


Gyan is also mentoring several key people to be part of the India team.


