In 2005, having just graduated from seminary, I was looking for a church to serve. Then Chairman of the Board John Haley invited me to consider Literacy & Evangelism (LEI) as an option for pastoral service. So, as I looked at churches, I also looked at what LEI was doing.



I joined LEI missionary Bob Biederman and

a primer construction team in Ghana, West Africa, where an LEI primer (basic reader) was being developed for the Dangme (Dong-may) people. This population includes a high percentage of non-readers.

The most gripping part of our two-plus weeks' stay came at the end of the primer construction workshop as we sat in a circle with seven Ghanaian team members and debriefed. Participants expressed their appreciation through tears, thanking us for bringing the linguistic expertise that would allow their brothers and sisters to learn to read the Bible for themselves in their own language.

A beautiful thing has occurred over the past several years. Literacy & Evangelism organizations have been formed in 14 other countries. Many of these have the linguistic capacity and skill needed to create new primers independently of North America. They have been trained and can now replicate and multiply the work by themselves.

Our effort to equip autonomous, indigenous L&E organizations around the world has led us into the most robust season in our history.

May our God continue to bless the efforts of LEI's growing network of organizations.

What Are LEI Literacy Primers?


Literacy & Evangelism's Bible-content primers are basic readers that can be easily used to help teach people to read in their heart language. For over 55 years, LEI missionaries and partners have constructed literacy primers in more than 275 languages. Because LEI primers are shared freely for download from the LEI website, we will never know how many lives the Lord has transformed in using these powerful tools to share the message of Jesus Christ while sharing the gift of reading.


LEI primers are:

- Culture-specific not translated from English materials.
- Consistent in lesson format.
- Written by speakers of the language.
- Illustrated by a local artist.
- Designed to be taught by non-professional volunteers.
- Accompanied by a detailed teacher's guidebook.

LEI primer lessons:

- Build on the vocabulary introduced in previous lessons.
- Usually introduce the name of Jesus by Lesson 12.
- Include Scripture verses for teacher and student to read and discuss.

LEI Primer Construction

1. **Advance Preparations:** 2. Team of nationals completes an Primer Construction extensive language Workshop: data worksheet, translates Two-book series of 82 illustrated Bible stories and teaching lessons created. Includes instructions, and prepares teacher instructions, culturefacilities for primer construction specific stories, math, health/ workshop (6 months). hygiene, agriculture, and 36 easy-to-read Bible stories (2 weeks). 3. Manuscript Draft Check: Revisions to the manuscript are made as needed (2 months). 4. Desktop Publishing: Desktop Publishers. who sometimes don't even know the language, create a 5. final draft (1 month). Follow-up: Primer checking and field-testing completed (3 months to one vear). 6. **Final Printing:** 1-2 years from start to finish.

Primer construction demands knowledge and skill, yet the final product is easy for teacher and student to use.

Teamwork Produces Primers Nzema Primer - LEI Ghana, Africa

To date, L&E Ghana has published 16 primers for its literacy library. These have been skillfully created and used to teach numerous new readers about God's love and His abundant compassion.

Recently, by supplying the consulting and technical staff, L&E Ghana worked with the Bible Society of Ghana to complete the Nzema primer's books and workbooks. The Nzema people comprise one of the largest undying tribes in Ghana with over 325,000 speakers. Nzema is not only spoken in southwestern Ghana but also in southeastern Ivory Coast.

As the Bible Society of Ghana mobilizes churches to get involved, L&E Ghana prepares its staff to train Christian volunteer teachers during Tutor Training Workshops. L&E Ghana will also assist with launching Nzema literacy classes in the area.

The gift of being able to read adds value to people's lives, but more importantly it illuminates the Lord and His plan and purpose. How precious it is that the Lord will speak to the Nzema more intimately while they read their Bibles in their mother tongue. In Nzema, we say, "Mo somaa" - "Thank you."

Rev. Samuel Lawerteh, Director of L&E Ghana, stated, "Doing missions in Ghana's economic difficulties is challenging and daunting." But God is faithful. Not only has L&E Ghana built its own literacy library, it also has assisted L&E Nigeria with several primer projects. Most recently, the Hausa primer has been revised with the addition of 10 Bible story lessons making 82 total. Moreover, they have collaborated in Nigeria's Tangale primer's final editing. Both primers are in use in literacy classes, having been printed and sent to Nigeria.

Concurrently L&E Ghana, working with the Church of Pentecost, finalized the Konkomba primer which is ready for printing and use.



Mooré Primers - Burkina Faso

Once upon a time, in the African country called Burkina Faso, the Burkinabè people were passionate about learning to read and write in the Mooré language, a local language spoken by the majority of people in their country. They struggled to find resources to learn and deepen their language skills until the day God remembered them, sending help from Literacy & Evangelism International (LEI-US). This organization graciously financed the printing of 2,000 literacy primers, Books 1 and 2 in the Mooré language.

Filled with hope, the learners waited eagerly to receive these books to begin their journey into the world of the Mooré language's alphabet, words, and phrases. When the long-awaited books arrived, learners were overwhelmed with joy and gratitude to all those who had generously donated support to make their learning possible.

Students gathered in a small classroom where a local teacher, also passionate about the Mooré language, joined them. Learners threw themselves into their studies with enthusiasm, following the lessons and exercises in the textbooks. Each page became a new discovery, a new victory in





their quest to master this precious written language. Making remarkable progress, beginning to understand the Mooré language script with confidence, they were very grateful to LEI-US and its benevolent donors. Thanks to them, they will be able to access the resources necessary to improve their lives and their relationship with their community.

Learners believe the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ accompanies them throughout their journey of learning. In their prayers, they ask God to bless the ministry of LEI-US so that others in Burkina Faso can also benefit from the opportunity to learn to read and write in their mother tongue.

Thanks to the students' determination, the help of LEI-US, and the blessing of God, learners will continue to learn and use the Mooré language in their daily lives becoming true disciple-making ambassadors for the Lord Jesus Christ through literacy in their language. Primer Construction Prevails Despite Pandemic Restrictions

Rev. Carey Jo Johnston, Director of LEI Canada, continues to explore new and innovative ways to make LEI's materials and methodologies accessible to the world. Carey Jo has led or assisted in numerous international, in-person primer construction workshops that have produced dozens of indigenous, Bible-based, literacy primers.

Yet, recent worldwide circumstances have challenged Carey Jo to try something new. She and the primer construction team have prevailed in creating a new LEI primer despite Covid pandemic restrictions that made in-person meetings impossible. Though it has taken years rather than the typical three weeks to create, this primer was constructed entirely online via Facebook video chat meetings. This necessary alternative allowed the work to move forward despite obstacles beyond anyone's control.

Carey Jo, Penny Fetters, Ana Biederman, a local Member Nation partner, and a number of other language experts were instrumental in developing this invaluable Bible-content literacy tool. Carey Jo reports, "70 lessons of the primer, including 24 easy-to-read Bible stories are complete." Presently, a final primer edit is being done with the help of local language speakers. Soon this primer will be ready for printing, distribution, and use.

Desktop Primer Publishing New Online Course

An LEI online course has been developed that focuses on teaching desktop publishing techniques unique to the creation of Literacy & Evangelism's primers. Each primer lesson contains custom pictures with new words and syllables distinctively aligned on a page in specialized text boxes.

Now that Patty Hickman, LEI's desktop publishing expert, has officially though not completely "retired," others need to be trained to do the exacting work that Patty has done for nearly 40 years.

Patty says, "Desktop publishing is the computer work of putting text and graphics (photos, illustrations, or other elements) together to create a professional-looking, interesting, high-quality publication."

"You can easily put text in a document," Patty continues, "and you can get illustrations in various ways, but putting them together to make a useful and eye-pleasing product is a little more difficult. The success and ease of the process is mainly the result of two different factors: the software used and the skill, knowledge, and experience of the worker.

"For me personally, I find desktop publishing to be a lot of fun. I think God created my brain to be detail-oriented. I enjoy spending hours doing what might seem tedious to some people, but to me it is like working interesting puzzles all day long."

Patty shares how she was once asked to select picture words to go with a Bible story included in a primer. "I cried when I selected two picture words for the story of Jesus dying on the cross. The first word meant 'He died for us.' The second picture word meant 'This is love."

We are thankful that all the expertise Patty has gathered is readily available for all who want to learn LEI's desktop publishing techniques. We appreciate the diligence of the primer development team and for Patty's many years of service with LEI




